- Legislative report. It has come to our attention that several Idaho state legislators were heard chatting about a motorcycle helmet bill for Idaho. Conversations of this kind only reinforce the call for us to be ever vigilant about proposed bills regarding motorcycles. The State of Washington has HB1625(?) regulating Motorcycles at traffic control signals. MT has introduced House Bill 534, a helmet law. *BikePAC of Idaho* (BPI) submitted a letter which is posted on the *BPI* website. OR has a bill (SB49) that prohibits motorcycle operators under 12 yrs old, even on private property. *AMA* posts this type of information to keep motorcyclists informed.
